Payment Options:

1. Payment in Full
2. Deposit (minimum \$50.00 per player) on registration and a post-dated cheque, dated July 31, 2010, for the balance. If anyone needs special payment arrangements, please contact Corrina Taylor, Registrar.
3. All other cheques (Rep tryout, Rep Fees, Jersey Deposit), dated as directed, must accompany registration.

Fundraising

When each player registers, their family will be given the choice of either taking a case of chocolates to sell at the cost of \$60.00, or paying a \$30.00 fundraising fee. If the family takes the case of chocolates, they keep the money and are totally reimbursed for their fee through this.

Family Plan

Our family plan is full price for first 2 players, and ½ price for each additional player. The lowest fee is halved. Any rep fees are still assessed. Jersey deposit must be paid for each player.

Rep Team Tryouts

Those wishing to try out for a Rep team (PeeWee, Bantam or Midget) will be required to pay a tryout fee, \$100.00 for both A & B. Atom players wishing to be assessed for A and B competitive teams will be required to pay an assessment fee of \$50.00 – Atom, PeeWee, Bantam & Midget tryout fee payable by July 15, 2010. The tryout fee is payable with your registration and is non-refundable. You must also include a cheque for Rep Fees of \$250.00 (Bantam & PeeWee) & \$350.00 (Midget), dated October 1st. This will only be cashed if the player is assigned to a rep team.

Any player with a desire to play on a rep team must attend the appropriate assessment. If ice is available, rep tryouts will start the last week of August. Please watch the website (www.jdfminorhockey.com) for dates.

Other Teams (Major Midget, Junior, Major Midget Female)

Any player trying out for these teams is required to register with JdFMHA in order to be guaranteed a roster spot should they be released by that team. Registration cheques for these players, other than the initial deposit to

hold the space, will not be cashed until the final outcome has been determined (as long as JdF is aware of the player's intentions – please make sure you indicate on your registration form and identify yourself to the registrar).

Proof of Residence

A Proof of Residence is required from all players, even those returning. This should be a recent utility bill (dated within the last 3 months) showing the current address of the player. If, for any reason, the name on the utility bill does not match that of the parent or guardian of the player, further identification will be required (e.g. driver's license with the correct address). All bills will be kept with registration forms and treated as confidential information.

Proof of Residence is required to confirm the player's residency within the Juan de Fuca Minor Hockey Association Draw Zone **every year**.

Any player who does not legally reside within the JdFMHA draw zone must produce written permission from BC Hockey to play with Juan de Fuca Minor Hockey.

Ice Schedules

Juan de Fuca Minor Hockey reserves the right to schedule games and practices as required in order to make our overall schedule effective. We have three rinks that will be used as we see fit. In registering for hockey, please be advised we cannot avoid scheduling the majority of the younger age groups on weekends, when we have most of our available times. All age groups must be prepared to attend early morning practices, starting as early as 6 am, when allocated, and older groups will have some evenings up to 10:30 pm. For Atom Division and up, some of the early morning practices will be on school days.
